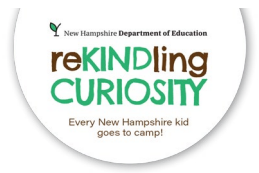




REKINDLING CURIOSITY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION



The New Hampshire Department of Education is partnering with New Hampshire camps and school-age summer programs across the state to offer students the unique opportunity to move beyond COVID-19 and be a kid again.

- Select the **Parent Start Your Application** button if you want to apply
 - This brings you to the ReKINDling page on FACTS where you will need to create an account
 - Be sure to select School Year 2022 – 2023
 - The Rekindling Curiosity Program will already be pre-selected. You **do not** add your camp at this step.
 - You will select the anticipated camp your child will be attending once in the application at step seven, additional information.
 - Camp fees should be entered a total amount you anticipate spending on camp for that child this summer (okay to attend more than one eligible camp/program even though you cannot list both on the application)
 - After “submitting” application, will need to upload the following proofs:
 - If you are qualifying via income, you will need to provide last year’s tax return.
 - If you are qualifying via eligible disability, you will need to provide a note from your child’s PCP or a current IEP.
 - NOTE: Some families may upload both if they qualify based on income but have one child who qualifies based on disability.
- Once the application is submitted, **the following steps will happen:**
 - You should receive a notification email that application is complete. If not, please follow-up with FACTS customer service at 866.441.4637 to see what you are missing
 - Award emails are sent out weekly; it may take up to three weeks for your application to be processed – please call FACTS customer service if you feel you should have received notification already and have not.
 - Within two weeks of receiving award email from Rekindling@doe.nh.gov, ClassWallet will send a welcome email with instructions on how to create an account and access funds – **please read this email in its entirety!**
 - Register for an account with Class Wallet using the link in your welcome email

- To send funds to the camp your child is attending, you will need to upload a bill, invoice, or receipt that includes:
 - Parent and Student information (first and last names, address)
 - Camp/Program information (name, address, tax ID)
 - Amount due (pertaining to the award recipient)
 - Period this amount covers
 - Summary of services rendered
 - Payment due date
 - Invoice or PO number established by the camp/program
- Payment requests will be reviewed and, if approved, funds will be sent to directly to the camp/program. **NOTE: Requests may take up to two weeks to be processed, please plan accordingly and work with your camp as needed.**
